

2019 NPC JURIED HIGH SCHOOL ART SHOW CALL FOR ENTRY

Northland Pioneer College will hold its 33rd Annual Juried High School Exhibit March 4th – April 5th, 2019, in the Talon Gallery at the White Mountain Campus in Show Low.

It is an honor to have one's work chosen for exhibit in a juried show. Artwork will be judged for Best of Show, 1st through 3rd place and honorable mention. Best of Show winners must be seniors and will be offered one-year, art tuition scholarships to Northland Pioneer College. Certificates will be given for all awards. Artwork in any media is eligible.

RULES

1. All entries must be original artwork by high school students (grades 9-12).
 - No reproductions of copyrighted material will be accepted
 - No reproductions of original artwork will be accepted. Please submit the original artwork. (ex: NO photocopies or prints of original drawings/paintings)
 - Entries must not have previously been shown in the Talon Gallery.
2. Students do not need to be currently enrolled in an art class or in a public high school.
3. Students are limited to 3 entries total.
4. Entry forms must be legible, completely filled out, and attached to the back of the work. Entries without attached form will not be accepted.
5. Artwork chosen for exhibit must remain on display for the entire duration of the exhibit.
6. Art tuition scholarships to NPC for 2019-2020 can be awarded to 12th grade students only. Scholarship winners will receive a letter sent to the address provided on the entry form.
7. Northland Pioneer College cannot provide storage for any work left after the pick-up date.
8. Northland Pioneer College and its employees are exempt from liability for damage or theft of any work submitted to this exhibit, assuming their provision for reasonable security and care.
