NPC ranked #1 in nation for certificates to Native Americans

Northland Pioneer College is the nation's top producer of Certificates of Proficiency awarded to Native American students, nearly doubling the number of

awardees from the 2012-13 academic year.

A recent analysis of 2013-14 academic year data from more than 1,600 community colleges by the national publication *Community College Weekly* showed NPC issued 108 certificates to Native Americans, up from 55 the previous year, which had earned a fifth place ranking.

NPC is also ranked 35th in the nation in the number of associate's degrees awarded to Native Americans, up from 89th the previous year, after also more than doubling degree completers.

NPC's totals for both certificates and degrees to Native Americans exceeded those from much larger public and private two- and four-year institutions.

Over 36 percent of NPC students classify themselves as Native American learners.
