Scholarships available to study Spanish in Costa Rica this summer

Spend four weeks immersed in the culture of Costa Rica this summer, studying beginning and advanced Spanish studies at the *Universidad de Costa Rica San Jose*. Scholarships are available for current NPC students, including dual and NAVIT students.

Students will earn six credits while attending week-day classes for four weeks, **June 25 to July 25**. The cost for tuition, room and 2 meals per day is **\$1,985**, plus airfare. Participants are responsible for obtaining their own passports and the purchase of textbooks.
