Check your contact information for new NPC Alert system

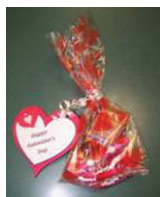
NPC has installed a new **emergency alert system** called **NPC Alert**. This alert system will be used to inform students, faculty and staff of NPC closures, major system failures, security threats or natural disasters.

The NPC Alert has **three** methods of notification – email, voice recorded messages and text messages. As a default, emergency notifications will **always** be sent to your official NPC email address.

You can choose to provide additional points of contact but you are **not** required to do so. Keep in mind that some points of contact are more reliable than others. Personal cell phones will be the most reliable, followed by a landline phone and then email. You should consider this when

choosing what contacts to supply. Directions on how to update your alert methods will be sent to your NPC email.

Students should make sure all of their contact information, including mailing address, is correct by logging in to their **MyNPC** account.
