## Free tax preparation assistance available for incomes <\$58,000

Free tax help and e-filing is available in Navajo and Apache counties for families with incomes less than \$58,000 through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program, sponsored by United Way of Northern Arizona and Northland Pioneer College.

The free tax preparation and e-filing service is being provided at all nine NPC campuses and centers. A schedule of dates, times and locations is posted at [www.npc.edu/free-tax-prep](http://www.npc.edu/free-tax-prep).

Community members seeking tax preparation assistance should bring this year's wage and earnings statements (Form W-2) from all employers, interest statements from banks (Form 1099), a copy of last year's tax return if available, and other relevant information about income and expenses, especially for child care. You also need to bring a photo ID, and original Social Security or ITIN cards. If filing jointly, both filers must be present to sign the return.
