You can now also renew your items online. From the library's main page, click "*Library Catalog*," then under "*My Account*" click "*My Checkouts*," enter your library card barcode number, then simply select the items to be renewed. Be sure to click the "*Renew*" button when you are done.

**Note:** limited to 1 renewal per item. Items must not have any Holds/Requests on them and your account cannot have fines of **\$10** or more.
