Visit your device's App Store, search for **In Case of Crisis Education**. Once downloaded, open the app, click the "+" sign and scroll through the list until you find **Northland Pioneer College**. You'll have the option to download for an individual campus/center, or for all locations. You'll find plenty of useful tools and suggestions on what to do in an emergency situation.
