

NPC will host University Transfer Fairs, Sept. 23 & 24

Current students, alumni and interested community members can obtain information about continuing their education at two Transfer Fairs on **Sept. 23** in **Show Low** and **Sept. 24** in **Winslow**, in the Learning Centers lobbies at both campuses from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Nine colleges and universities will be represented, including Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University, University of Arizona, Grand Canyon University, Prescott College, Utah State University, Western New Mexico University, Benedictine University and Northcentral University.

The out-of-state schools are part of the Western Undergraduate Exchange (www.wiche.edu/wue) where students can qualify for discounted non-resident tuition. Both USU and WNMU have in-state tuition agreements for Native American students meeting certain residency requirements.
