WMC parking lot construction update

If you've been by the Show Low campus anytime this summer you would have seen plenty of construction activity as crews re-built parking areas, increasing from less than 200 to almost 500 spaces.

There are now 2 entrances from Whipple providing access to the campus. On Aug. 29, asphalt was being laid in the area by the Cosmetology Center and is expected to be available, using the western-most entrance from the Deuce of Clubs, on Tuesday, Sept. 4.

Then work will concentrate on a second entrance from the Deuce, a round-a-bout, bus loading area and loop road connecting to the Aspen Center.
