Kids, parents new Library program

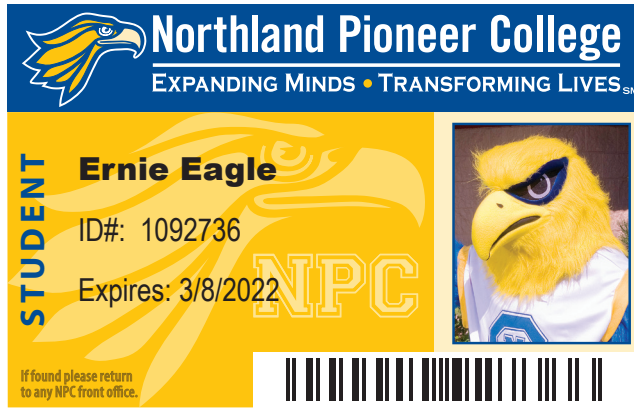
DISCOVERY NEST
