



Applications due Nov. 12 for All-AZ Academic Team

Members of the **All-Arizona Academic Team** receive Board of Regents tuition waivers, for up to 60 credits, to complete their bachelor's degree at one of the three Arizona public universities.

You could be one of the 18 NPC students (2 per campus or center) to receive this academic honor, but you must complete the online application by **Nov. 12**. Applicants must have taken a class at or originating from that location to be considered for one of the two nominations.



You must have a GPA of 3.5 or better and be on track to complete your associate or bachelor's degree. Involvement in community or college activities, such as student government, tutoring or assisting in hunger relief, is considered in the selection process.
