Join members of the Navajo County Community College District Governing Board, local dignitaries, NPC staff and students at Noon on **Friday, Oct. 19**, to officially break ground for the new Skills Center on the Holbrook – Painted Desert Campus.

The 26,600-square-foot Skills Center has dedicated areas for both plastic and metal welding training, shop areas for construction technology, and shared computer based training classrooms. There is also space for industrial maintenance and operations students and future programs, possibly tied to potash mining.

Whiteriver Construction is building the facility, with intended completion in time for fall 2013 classes.

## Photovoltaic, solar application workshops at SCC

Sustainability construction pioneer Joe Costion will be offering two introductory hands-on noncredit workshops on photovoltaic systems and solar energy applications at the Snowflake/Taylor – Silver Creek Campus. Each workshop costs **\$32** and meets in the Learning Center, room 101, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Costion introduces solar energy theory, photovoltaic terms and uses in his **Introduction to Photo Voltaic Systems** workshop (*BOC 099x-34856*) on Saturday, **Oct. 20**. Workshop participants will learn the differences between grid-tied and off-grid systems and learn about wiring panels, system grounding, and the various methods for mounting photovoltaic equipment.
