### 1098t's mailed to qualifying students

NPC is required to report certain tuition payments for students qualifying for the **HOPE SCHOLARSHIP TAX CREDIT** and **LIFETIME LEARNING TAX CREDIT** on Form **1098T**.

You can view your statement by logging into your **MyNPC** student account. Please see your tax professional or the IRS for deductibility of the amounts reported on your 1098T.
