

## Graduation participation application deadline, March 4

Students planning to participate in NPC's **37th Commencement Ceremony** must apply for graduation no later than **Friday, March 4**. In addition to the application, students must also respond to the invitation to participate in the ceremony by **April 15**.

"Deadlines will be strictly enforced," noted **Hallie Lucas**, Commencement Coordinator.

The event will begin at 1 p.m. on Saturday, **May 14**, at the Show Low School District Auditorium. All seating is reserved, with a ticket required for admission.

Students should consult with their academic adviser to determine graduation eligibility. There is a **\$35** nonrefundable fee, which covers invitations, and use of a cap & gown.

### 1098T's mailed to qualifying students

NPC has mailed **Form 1098T** to qualifying students. The data on the Form 1098T is the only information NPC has available to assist students in claiming the **American Opportunity** or **Lifetime Learning** credits.

Students can obtain a copy of **IRS Publication 970** and/or consult their tax adviser to properly interpret the data on the **Form 1098T** to determine if they qualify for either of the credits.
