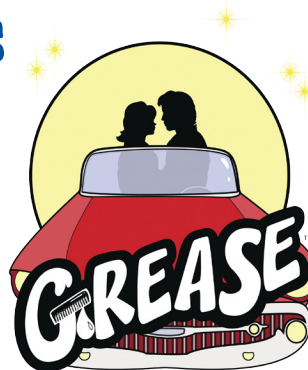


# Order tickets now for Grease shows
