Important information about financial aid

Financial aid students who have been awarded and are in good academic standing at the end of the fall 2010 semester may begin receiving their financial aid refunds on **December 22, 2010**. This will allow students to purchase their books before the start of the spring 2011 semester.

Students who are not enrolled by **December 18, 2010** will not receive a financial aid refund until the next financial aid disbursement date, which is **January 5, 2011**, if they are registered.

Note: Students may have a delay in financial aid refunds if grades are not posted to the students' academic transcript at the time financial aid refunds are disbursed. Date for final grades due for fall 2010 semester: **December 15, 2010**.

Students who apply late for financial aid should make payment arrangements at the time of registration. Payments should include tuition, fees and book charges.

Financial aid processing time is 6 weeks once the last document is received by the financial aid office.

All financial aid forms and documents must be mailed, sent intercampus mail, or e-mailed to: financialaid@npc.edu.

All financial aid forms must have signatures. Forms without signatures will cause an additional delay in processing.

Copies of federal tax returns must be signed. Do not submit state tax returns. Federal tax returns without signatures will cause an additional delay in processing.
