

# Going Green: Access Your Grades Online

In an effort to save paper and postage, the Records & Registration Office will no longer be mailing grade reports to students.

You can access your grades by logging on to **MyNPC** (<https://MyNPC.npc.edu/ics>) from your personal or NPC library or lab computer. Just click on the **MYNPC** button on NPC's website, [www.NPC.edu](http://www.NPC.edu).

If you do not have access to a computer, you can submit a **FINAL GRADES REQUEST FORM**. This form is available from campus/center offices, academic advisors or on **MyNPC**. It will take approximately 4–5 business days to process the request **AFTER** all grades for the semester have been submitted. Instructors are to have all grades submitted to the Records Office by Dec. 23. There is no charge.
