Congratulations on the service you have given your country. Now is the time to use the educational benefits you have invested in. You have invested in the Montgomery GI Bill through your military service.

Now is the time to realize that investment. You have 10 years from the date of discharge to use your investment. Begin now. Once your in-

vestment has reached that 10 year delimitating date your investment is gone.

Northland Pioneer College is approved to offer Educational programs for Veterans under the Montgomery GI Bill (Chp. 30), Survivors and Dependents of Veterans (Chp. 35), Selected Reservists (Chp. 1606) and the new Reserve Education Assistance Program (Chp. 1607). Northland

is also approved to offer Educational Training to veterans who qualify for Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Program (Chp. 31).

The Veterans Administration offers information on all Veterans Services at www.gibill.va.gov. This site will give you the current monthly benefit you will receive upon your enrollment at Northland Pioneer College.
