Access financial aid forms online

Applying for financial assistance to pay for Northland Pioneer College classes is now just a mouse click away.

Many of the forms used in the application process are now available to download from the college's Students Services website, www.npc.edu/studentsservices.html. Previously forms had to be obtained from advisors or the Financial Aid Office in Holbrook.

There are step-by-step instructions on how to apply for financial assistance, and a link to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You'll also find the NPC Financial Aid Information Sheet, a scholarship letter of interest, forms for reporting low income and verification worksheets. Links to other pages explain the financial aid award letter and the meaning of satisfactory academic progress. Another link takes you to a full list of available scholarships.

Forms currently can not be filled out and submitted online. An upgrade to NPC computer sys-

tems to allow secure data transfers is being implemented. A joint U.S. Department of Education Title III grant with Coconino Community College has funded creation of the electronic resources now being utilized to better serve students. Additional services and resources are now in development.

Other services now available online for students include online advising, admissions, disability resource, tutoring and veterans information. The Career Services section includes links to career planning tools and job listings, both on- and off-campus.

Students planning to enroll in spring classes should begin the financial aid process as soon as possible. It can take two to four weeks to complete the process. Financial Aid representatives have been visiting campus and center locations on a monthly basis.
