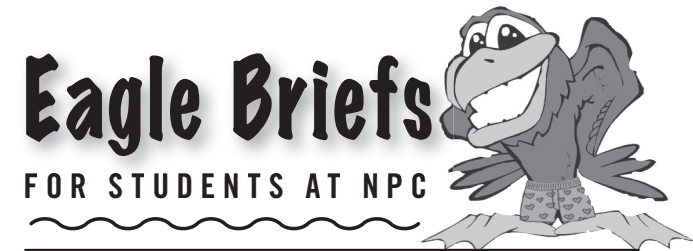


## Now It's Easier to Access Your Online Classes and MORE!
